

HOW TO REACH THE BLM WEB SITE

Open Google or other search engine

Type lake havasu blm (If you are viewing this doc online click [here](#))

Click Lake Havasu BLM Field Office or

Click BLM Arizona Lake Havasu Field Office

Click Havasu Travel Management Plan

Right Click If you want to put it on your desktop or save it somewhere – Vista may be different THAN Windows XP

Click Create short cut

Click Yes (this will place the Havasu TMP Maps icon on your desk top or wherever you want to save it)

Exit Now you can open the maps easily just by clicking on that icon on your desktop. You can also click or drag the icon to a folder if you want it someplace else

Click Maps and Documentiom - This will open to
1-64,000 BLM Maps

Documentation: can usually go straight to the HN number by opening part A, B, C and typing the HN number in the FIND box above & clicking to the right, then on the first line that opens, below the find box (patience while it finds it)

1-12,000 Maps (split in 23 separate maps, check map index to locate the map number of the area you want, then click on that number)

Support Map D with any changes you might recommend. Cross check MAP C to see the differences. Many more routes are proposed closed on MAP C Routes. BLM uses many routes in a trail; any route can close a whole trail. Use your GPS track (Printed off) to locate all the routes on your trail

YOU CAN BLOW THE MAPS UP BY CHANGING THE % ABOVE THE MAP. You can also print (right click) parts of the map to record your trail & include in you comments to BLM (drawn your trail on the map, in green, mark the closed Routes in red)
