The Python Trail starts about one mile south of the scenic turn out at GPS coordinate N34 22.538 W114 09.790 and Finish N34 072 W114 09.989. See attached map.

This entire track was GPS'd by the Havasu 4 Wheelers and has been accidentally omitted from any of the proposed alternatives.

I have submitted a map showing the Track.

1. I believe this trail falls under "Evidence of Construction" into the regularly maintained category. This is a technical trail and is used by experienced off roaders.
2. under the "SPECIAL RESOURCES" this trail should be considered as an "Indirect" because it is a specific stand alone trail.
3. In the "PUBLIC USES" UNDER "Public Use" this trail is more challenging than a Standard Stock 4X4 can accommodate.
4. In the "Route Redundancy" IN THE "Public Uses" the answer should be No Because this is a specific stand alone trail.
