Comments relating to Havasu Mid Mohave to West Mohave
HN478, HN479, HN466, and Missed route linking these two routes

We support Map D with the following changes. Map C and D show HN478 and HN466 as closed. The middle portion is a connector route between these two that was missed by BLM. As you can see from the attached maps HN478, HN479, HN466 and the missed route between, starting at 34 27' 04.80N and ending at 114 05" 42.04W, were on Google earth prior to May 2007. Contrary to BLM documentation, all of this set of routes is maintained regularly by users. All are two track stock 4X4 trails. This is a long used cut across from West to Mid Mohave. All are part of a loop trail and a connector to several other trails, and save miles of extra driving over desert trails. All of the routes,/trails should be open and not closed or even not open mitigated.

Again, we support Map D with this change.
